### **LEARN WITH THE GIANTS**

The Creative Industries (CI) Apprenticeship Scheme lowers the employment barriers for entry CI jobs by increasing employers' receptiveness to hire new entrants. Entrant professionals, managers and executives will be able to acquire hands-on industry experience, thereby boosting their employability.

### If you're the employer:

- · You enjoy savings through salary and course fee subsidies; and
- You boost your organisation's productivity by focusing on its core business instead
  of investing extra resources to facilitate in-house training.

The Apprenticeship Scheme is open to employers in the Creative Industries only.

### If you're the apprentice:

- You earn a salary during training;
- · You work alongside experienced CI practitioners to gain job-specific skills;
- You receive industry-relevant training that is accredited under the nationally recognised Creative Industries Workforce Skills Qualifications (CI WSQ) framework.

### How it works:

The scheme consists of two components, namely CI WSQ training programme and onthe-job training component. The total duration of the apprenticeship programme can last between 3 and 12 months.

The CI WSQ training programme is administered by training partners appointed by WDA. Apprentices will undergo a structured training programme that is delivered by these appointed training partners. Apprentices will also be involved in actual hands-on work assigned by the company and receive on-the-job training under the supervision of qualified and skilled staff.

Are you a freelancer within the Creative Industries? If yes, you can now enjoy higher course fee funding of up to 90% under the Creative Industries Freelancers Enhanced Support for Courses (CI FRESCO) when you sign up for CI WSQ courses.

### You are eligible if:

- a. You have worked as a freelancer in the same or related specialisation over the past 12 months:
- b. You have embarked on freelance project(s) or have completed at least 6 cumulative months of freelance project(s) within the past 12 months.

If you do not meet the criteria, you can still enjoy the prevailing course fee subsidy of up to 70% from WDA.

### Application:

Interested freelancers can apply directly to the respective CI WSQ training providers and will be evaluated on their eligibility accordingly.

# THIS IS CET QUALIFICATION AWARD







### A LITTLE EXTRA CASH REWARD

Get rewarded for upgrading your skills. The new CET Qualification Award (CQA) aims to encourage you to attain full qualifications, so that you will be equipped in more ways than one.

### You are eligible if:

You are a Singapore citizen who attained full qualifications for the first time from 1 March 2011.

### Your cash awards:

- If you successfully complete and are awarded a subsidised part-time Diploma at the Polytechnics or a WSQ Diploma/Specialist Diploma, you are eligible for a CET Qualification Award (CQA) of \$1,000.
- If you successfully complete and are awarded a WSQ Certificate/Higher Certificate/ Advanced Certificate or a part-time NITEC/Higher NITEC, you will also be eligible for a CET Qualification Award (CQA) of \$200.
